- ☐ Lace Pods—white to tan
- ☐ Spoke Pods—white to tan

Late March - April:

- ☐ Narrow-leaf Mule Ears—yellow
- ☐ Blow Wives—white
- ☐ Phacelia—violet to blue
- ☐ Dutchman's Pipe(vine)—ivory
- ☐ Hedge Nettle—purple to rose
- ☐ Douglas Iris—violet to blue
- ☐ Parsnip (*Pestel Lomatium*)—white
- ☐ Parentucellia—yellow

Late April - May - June:

- ☐ Chines Houses—violet to blue
- ☐ Bellardia—white to pink
- ☐ Winecup Clarkia—deep red to rose
- ☐ Soap Plant—white
- ☐ Catchfly—white
- ☐ Allium—pink
- ☐ Ookow—blue to purple
- ☐ Mariposa Lilies (Gold Nuggets)—yellow
- ☐ Harvest Brodiaea—purple
- ☐ Ithuriel's Spear—purple
- ☐ Torillis—yellow
